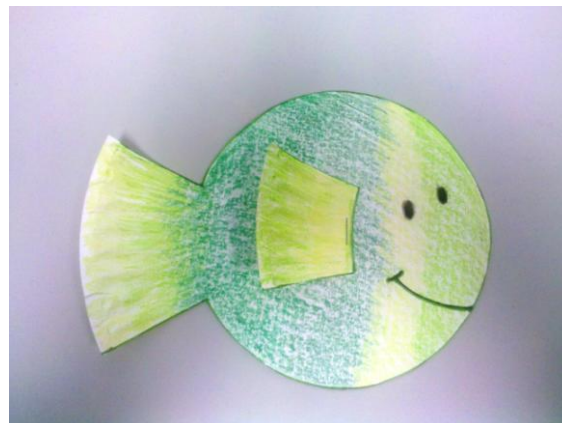




Big Brothers Big Sisters

Paper Plate Fish



What you'll need: 1 paper plate, scissors, markers, and stapler

Directions: Use the template or draw your own fish on the paper plate. Cut out your fish and fin. Color your fish, add a face and staple the fin to the body. You're done!

Paper Plate Turtle



What you'll need: 1 paper plate, scissors, markers, and stapler

Directions: Use the template to trace your turtle bodies on the paper plate. Trace or draw legs in the center of the page. Cut out your turtle bodies and legs. You can draw the details on the shell, color your turtle, and add a face. Staple on your legs and you're done!

Paper Plate Lion



What you'll need: 1 paper plate, scissors, markers

Directions: Start by drawing a circle around the center flat part of the plate. Next, draw lines around the circle to the edge of the plate. You can draw a face and color your lion. Using scissors, cut around the edge to create the mane. You're done!

Paper Plate Snake



What you'll need: 1 paper plate, scissors, markers

Directions: Start by drawing your tail close to the edge of the plate. Then draw a line that circles in to the center. Draw a second line about 1 inch from your other line to create the body. Draw a head in the center of the plate. You can add a tongue and eyes. Cut out the body of your snake and color it. You're done!

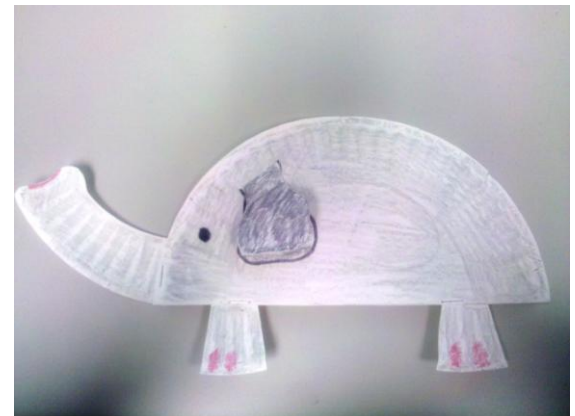
Paper Plate Cow



What you'll need: 1 paper plate, scissors, markers, and stapler

Directions: Use the template to trace your cow's body, head, legs and tail on the paper plate. Cut out your cow's body, head, legs and tail. You can draw the details on the body and face. Staple on the head, legs and tail to the body. You're done!

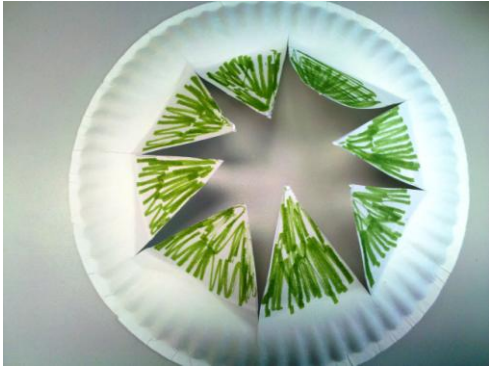
Paper Plate Elephant



What you'll need: 1 paper plate, scissors, markers, and stapler

Directions: Use the template to trace the body, ear, trunk and feet on the paper plate. Cut out your elephant's body, ear, trunk and feet. Color your elephant. Staple on the ear, trunk and feet to the body. You're done!

Paper Plate Flower Hat



What you'll need: 2 paper plates, scissors, markers, and stapler

Directions: First, take one paper plate and color the center of the plate (which will become your grass). Draw lines across the center of the plate to create 8 sections. Cut along the lines to create 8 triangles, fold them up towards the edge of the plate. Draw flowers on the second plate, color and cut them out. Staple the flowers to the "grass". You're done!
