



Big Brothers Big Sisters

Tabletop Shuffleboard

About: Here is a mini, tabletop version of the classic game, Shuffleboard!

What you'll need: print both pages of this activity, 6 pennies, 2 paperclips, tape

How to play:

1. Each player gets 3 pennies, one person plays “heads” up and the other is “tails” up.
2. Tape the two pages together so that the BBBS logo is at one end and the triangle is at the other. This is your game board, place it on a flat, hard surface with the triangle away from you.
 - The top of the logo is your start line, you must start behind this ‘line.’
3. Use the paperclips to keep track of your points on the scoreboards provided on the sides of the board.
4. Take turns sliding your pennies towards the triangle. You want your penny to land on a numbered space. The bigger the number, the more points you get!
5. After all 6 pennies have been played, count up your points. If your penny is on one of the numbered spaces, you get that number of points (or minus points)
 - If your penny was on a space but got bumped off by another penny, you don't get the points.
 - If your penny is partly on a space and partly off, you get the points only if at least half of the penny is on the space
 - If your penny is sitting on the line between two spaces, you get points for the space where most of the penny is.
